

Directions to Bryn Mawr College

By Train

Amtrak (800-USA-RAIL) has frequent service from Philadelphia's 30th Street Station. At the 30th Street Station you can transfer to a direct commuter train to Bryn Mawr on the area's mass transit provider, SEPTA. Take the Paoli/Thorndale line to the Bryn Mawr station.

From the Bryn Mawr Station, you can either take a taxi to Rhoads Hall on the Bryn Mawr campus or walk.

The taxi service operates 7 days a week from 5:30 a.m. to 12:30 a.m. Taxis are often waiting for passengers at the entrance to the station. You may also call on a direct-line phone located on the train platform.

The campus is a five-minute walk from the Bryn Mawr train station. You want to be on the north, residential side of the station. (Take the stairs under the track if you are on the south side.) From the north side of the station walk straight ahead on Morris Avenue for two blocks. You will cross Montgomery Avenue, (traffic light) and proceed one more block to the corner of Morris Ave and Yarrow Street. Turn left on Yarrow Street and proceed about three blocks to a driveway/street just before Goodhart Hall. Turn right and proceed to the end of that driveway, arriving at Rhoads Hall, where you will register and be housed.

By Plane

From Philadelphia Airport, you may take a taxi (about a 20-30 minute drive to the campus) or you may take SEPTA, the Regional Rail system, to Philadelphia's 30th Street station, where you will transfer to SEPTA's Paoli-Thorndale line (see above -- "By Train".)

SEPTA (Airport High Speed Line) has four stops within the airport (at terminals A, B, C/D, and E/F.) When you catch the train from the airport, make sure to let the conductor know your final destination is Bryn Mawr, and hold onto your ticket receipt for the train you transfer to in Philadelphia to avoid an extra fare.
